## C. BUILDING UPGRADING AND MAINTENANCE

- ♥ Upgrading of all toilets and bathroom facilities including sanitary ware, floors, wall tiles, painting, etc.
- ♥ Upgrading of security system by adding additional cameras and relocating of cameras
- ♥ Insolation of roof void areas (above ceilings) ±600m<sup>2</sup>
- ♥ General painting of all areas inside and outside
- ♥ Roof repairs (roof tiles, fascia boards, eve's closures, gutters, etc.)
- ♥ Repairs to the washing lines
- ♥ Upgrading of solar system, solar panels and battery system
- ♥ Install geyser wise switches to hot water system
- ♥ Secure pumproom building including sliding door, burglar bars and alarm system.
- ♥ Fire compliance: upgrade fire panel, roof void firewalls, fire signage, etc.
- ♥ Rainwater and storm water system (Greenhouse)
- ♥ Repair of damaged vinyl flooring of 2 passages and bedrooms of complete replacement.
- ♥ Repair of tar surfaces of front parking including painting of road marking, no parking & parking bays.



- ♥ Replace rusted roof sheeting and side gladding to external stores.
- ♥ Replace timber of 2 rotten timber windows.
